BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT this resolution be forwarded to the Premier of Ontario, the Minister of the Solicitor General, the Minister of Finance, the Minister of Northern Economic Development and Growth, the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO), the NOMA, and All Northern Ontario Municipalities.
