



BY-LAW 2026-012

BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE CLERK TREASURER TO EXECUTE AND RENEW AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN HIS MAJESTY, THE KING, IN RIGHT OF THE PROVINCE OF ONTARIO AS REPRESENTED BY THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNITY SAFETY AND CORRECTIONAL SERVICES ON BEHALF OF THE ONTARIO PROVINCIAL POLICE FOR THE PROVISION OF 9-1-1 PRIMARY PSAP SERVICES KNOWN AS NEXT GENERATION 9-1-1 SERVICES (NG 9-1-1 SERVICES).

WHEREAS Section 10.2.6 of the Municipal Act, 2001 as amended, provides that Council may pass By-laws for health, safety and well-being of persons of the Municipality;

AND WHEREAS Council deems it desirable and necessary to enter into/renew an agreement on behalf of the Municipality with the Ontario Provincial Police for the provision of answering and reporting services for 9-1-1 emergency services;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Mattawan enacts the following;

1. THAT the Clerk Treasurer is hereby designated as the signing officer and is authorized to execute and enter into an agreement on behalf of the Municipality with the Ontario Provincial Police for the provision of 9-1-1 Primary Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP) for a ten-year term;
2. That the said agreement attached hereto as "Schedule A" forms part of this By-law;
3. That the term of this agreement shall be effective from July 9, 2026 until July 9, 2036;
4. That any By-Law and resolutions inconsistent with this By-law is hereby repealed;
5. That this By-law comes into force and takes effect upon the date of its final passing.

READ A FIRST, SECOND, AND THIRD TIME, ENACTED AND PASSED BEFORE AN OPEN COUNCIL, THIS 9TH DAY OF JULY, 2026.
